

SADHANA YATRA

'VEDIC YAGYA CENTER' AND PUNDIT SAMAVEDULA INVITES YOU
TO ENJOY THE FOLLOWING SPIRITUAL TOUR PROGRAMM

TOUR DURATION: 13' Sept – 23' Sept 2016

TOUR SUMMARY: This Yatra is devoted to worship the most important nakshatra in your life – Chandra (Moon) nakshatra, Mother Lakshmi and Lord Kubera to get their blessings, stabilize and improve our material life and Lord Nrsimha to get divine protection. During this tour under the direct guidance of Pundit Samavedula for the first 3 days we will do NAKSHATRA SAHITA AND LAXMI KUBERA NRASIMHA YAGYAM with around 21-30 vedic pundits in Pundit Samavedula ashram. Also each person will do individual authentic ritual for ancestors peace and their blessings and much more. After that we will visit secret and not widely known NAKSHATRAM TEMPLES which relates with each group member's Chandra nakshatra and it's pada (exact degree range of each tour member's kundli/horoscope). In addition to that, we will visit powerful and God manifested one of the SHAKTI PEET temples in South India, also we will visit 4 of 5 vedic Panchrama Kshetra's temples and do other things. We will get blessings from Devas and pundits.

ASTROLOGICAL SIGNIFICANCE OF THE TOUR: During the first 3 days of the yagyams pundits will work with your rashis (*zodiac signs*) and nakshatrams (*lunar mansions*) using the mantras. During temple tour you will work with your Chandra (Moon) nakshatra and respected rashi where your Chandra is located. Chandra nakshatra is most important nakshatra for every human because that is the Lord of all nakshatras and it also represents our mind and ourselves. Strengthening of your rashis, grahas (*planets*) and nakshatras will automatically strengthen your kundali (*horoscope*) in general. When your horoscope becomes more stronger through all those upayas (means) then your life also turns to more positive and joyful direction.

Day 1&2 (13/14Sept)

Flight to Delhi (Sept 13) from your place of residence.
Flight to Vijayavada on Sept.14 at 13.15 (from Terminal 3);
Arriving in Vijayavada at 16.35 p.m.; Drive to Gataway Hotel and take the rest (swimming pool, dinner, etc.).

Day 3 (15 sept)

NAKSHATRA SAHITA AND LAXMI KUBERA NARASIMHA YAGYAM starts this day and goes for 3 days. For nakshatra yagyams and some other vedic rituals for each group member separate group of pundits will be assigned. Some rituals will be done at big homa kund or in front of all chanting pundits.

09.30 – After breakfast drive to ashram. Chandra NAKSHATRAM and NAVAGRAHA homam for each person individually*
13.00 - Lunch and rest time;
15.00 – 18.45 LAXMI HOMA with Lotus flowers followed by PURUSH SOOKT HOMA and SUDARSHAN HOMA.
At the end of this day evening Aarti will be performed and beautiful chanting of mantra pooshpam;
19.00 – Drive to hotel.



• All rituals in those 3 days will be performed on individual person's name and nakshatra with not less then 26-30 highly qualified vedic pundits. In this day morning part pundits will do specific mantras and rituals to invoke energy on each person (using name/surname/nakshatra). Upon our arriving main part of yagyam will start and will continue for the next 2 full days. All pictures show what you will see and experience in life.

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Day 4 (16 sept)

09.00 – After breakfast we drive to ashram. Second part of nakshatram and navagraha homam for each person individually;

13.00 – Lunch and rest;

14.30 – 19.30 KUBERA HOMA followed by CHANDI HOMA, PRATYANGIRA HOMA, KAMALATMIKA HOMA (all wealth and prosperity sankalpams use)

followed by evening Aarti and mantra pushpam ;

19.00 – Drive to hotel.



Day 5 (17 sept)

Pitru paksh starts (period when we honour our passed ancestors, especially through rituals) and in the early morning one part of the group drives to Krishna river to perform TARPANA PUJA** (one pundit for each member) and then back to hotel.

09.00 - We leave to the ashram after breakfast;

10.30 – Nakshatra and Navagraha dhaanams (voluntary) ***

- Final rituals for Nakshatrams and grahams with authentic chantings from RIGVEDA followed by RUDRA HOMA ;

13.30 – 15.30 – Lunch and rest;

15.00 – Final grand event of those days – PADMA PUSHPAM YAGYAM (flowers yagya for family prosperity and harmony) followed by MAHAPOORNAHUTI (Specific vedic ritual done at all homa kundas and this marks the completion of the all previous rituals). All yagyam days ends with full MANTRA PUSHPAM (vedic chanting from Yajurveda, considered as the flower of all vedic chants. Chanted only at the end of rituals and through this process we forward our wishes to almighty), followed by final blessings from all pundits;

20.30 – Drive to hotel.

** Vedic rituals to remove our ancestors negative carma on lineage that goes till 7th generations;

*** NAVAGRAHA and NAKHSATRA DHAAN is ancient vedic ritual when appropriate person who has specific graha (planet) qualities have been chosen and under mantram chanting you give him donations in form of specific commodities/grains and money and therefore “get rid of” of negative planets influence. This is one of vedic upaiya system how to reduce negative influence of specific planet and strengthen it.

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Day 6 (18 sept)

In the early morning second part of the group drives to Krishna river to perform **TARPANA PUJA*** (each individually with separate pundit) and back to hotel; **12.00 - Check out and drive to Kakinada city;** **18.00 - Arriving in hotel (GRT Grand hotel or Royal Park hotel); Dinner and rest .**

* Vedic rituals to remove our ancestors negative carma on lineage that goes till 7th generations.

** According to the vedic tradition, after yagyam most beneficial and right action human can do in its life is to visit temples because that action finishes human duty against those deities.



Day 7 (19 sept)

08:00 - After breakfast group splits into 2 or 3 parts and drive to nakshatra temples for darshan (only those nakshatra temples which corresponds to each group member's Nakshatra and related pada (exact degree range)). In picture you can see Pushyami nakshatra 2nd pada temple called Sri Bhadrakali Sametha Veereswara Swamy Siripuram temple.

- In the late afternoon all group members together will visit one of the 18 SHAKTI PEET and one of Shiva Pancharamas temples called BHIMESWARA SWAMY TEMPLE DRAKSHARAMAM. Darshan, archana, aarti and blessings of the pundits; 19.00 - Back to hotel.



General info: Every human on this world falls under 27 nakshatras, 108 padas and 12 rashi temples taking into account his/her Janma nakshatram (constellation and degree of the Moon on the time of the birth). Vedic logic says that to get rid of ill effects of the planets you must visit corresponding Janma nakshatram temple (your Moon constellation temple), Rashi Linga (temple which corresponds to your nakshatra rashi (Moon zodiac sign) and then visit Pancharama kshetras or five ancient vedic temples which relates to Lord Shiva.

About PANCHRAMA KSHETRAS: There are long stories in Puranas about those 5 temples but according to legend, these five pieces of one big shivling were installed as Sivalingas at five different temples by Indra, Surya, Chandra, Vishnu and Kumara Swamy at the respective places. We will in total visit 4 or 5 Panchrama Kshetra temples (Drakshrama; Somarama, Kshreerama, Kumararama).



DRAKSHARAMAM TEMPLE: famous as both Shiva kshetra and Shakti kshetra. Lord Bheemeswara swamy and Manikyamba are main deities. According to legend built by angels overnight around 10th century and Shivling at the temple was installed by *God Surya*. Construction of temple perimeter was not completed till sunrise and still stands uncomplete. Many times construction were finished but always collapsed within few months. Early morning tender Sun light falls on the Shiva Lingam. The Shiva linga is of a crystal texture. There are black stripes on the upper part. These are said to be the markings of the tiger skin worn by Lord Shiva when He was in disguise of a Hunter when he fought with Arjuna. Manikyamba Devi's shrine is present in backside of the temple at the left corner. Goddess face is looking towards left, signifying her as Vamachara Devatha.

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Day 8 (20 sept)

08:00 – After breakfast group splits into 2-3 parts and drives to RASHI temples for darshan (only those rashi temples which corresponds to each group member's Chandra (Moon) rashi sign;

- In the afternoon group visits other Pancharama Kshetra temples, like KUMARARAMA TEMPLE;

19.00 – Back in hotel.

In picture on the left you can see Karka (Cancer zodiac sign) rashi temple (deities) called UTTARA SOMESWARA SWAMY TEMPLE which corresponds to Pushyami nakshatra.



KUMARARAMA TEMPLE: Built around 9th century.

Mentioned in many Puranas as yogakshetram, which means, the person who has the "yogam" ("fated to have" or "opportunity given by god" or "boon") to visit, will visit the temple. Lord Shiva is known as Kumara Bhimeswara Swamy here and is in the form very big Shiva linga through 2 floors. According to legend, the Shivlinga at the temple place was installed and established by *Lord Kumaraswamy*. The temple has a mandapam that is supported by 100 pillars and is of a great architectural importance.



Day 9 (21 sept)

08:00 – After breakfast group will visit outstanding PANCHRAMA KSHETRA temples (in case not all visited within previous days) and leave to Visakapatnam

19.30 – Arriving in Visakapatnam

SOMARAMA TEMPLE: Built around 3rd century. Here Lord SHIVA is known as Someswara Swamy .The consort of Lord Someswara is Sri Rajarajeswari Ammavaru. The Sivalinga at this place is installed and established by *Lord CHANDRA*. Shivaling will change its color according to Moon phases. At the time of Pournami shivaling will be in white color and in Amavasya days its color shades black.

KSHEERARAMA TEMPLE: Built around 10th century. The Shivlinga was established by *Lord VISHNU*. It is believed that staying one day in Ksheerarama is equivalent to staying one year in Varanasi. The temple tower is one of the tallest among the temple towers between temples in India (See pict.on the left).

Day 10 (22 sept)

08:15 a.m. – Flight to Delhi; Arriving in Delhi 10:50 a.m. Drive to hotel close to international Airport, relaxation at nice swimming pool and peacefull surrounding. In evening part you can visit Ambience shopping mall if you wish (few miles by taxi)

Day 11 (23 sept)

08.00 – After breakfast or till noon checkout and drive to the Delhi airport. Flight to your country of residence.

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INFORMATION ABOUT SADHANA YATRA

- This trip is for serious devotees and not simple tourism, this is for people who really wants to come closer to Divinity; We promise you that such level of Divine energy you have never experienced!
- The price for tour program is **3950 USD**;
- Price includes comfortable a/c minivan transport between Day 2 and Day 9; all yagyas and rituals costs (Incl. ingredients, pundits salaries, etc); lunch during yagyams in ashram;
- Excluded costs are International and domestic travel, hotel costs and all other meals, charity , donations, tickets in temples or/to pundits/or for archanam or poojam; dhaan amount for day 5; any other costs. Minimal amount of travelers is 7; maximum is 12 people;
- Please take into account that all the temples that we will visit are self manifested/or very old and powerful temples. Energy there and energy you will get from yagyas could create rather kind of mental and physical conditions. Due to it in case you want to relax some day/or part of the day or skip some travel please feel free to do it;
- All yagyas will be done on your name/surname/nakshatra; Yagyas for ancestors will be done using ancestors names according to lists prepared in advance;
- If you want to order some individual yagya or upaiya for you in the ashram then it should be arranged before arriving there. Amount of pundits during Days 3-5 depends on tour attendees but will not be less than 21-26 vedic pundits;
- The journey dates now are fixed but please take into account that if there are unexpected problems then changes will be applied by considering specific circumstances.
- With accepting this journey person confirms understanding that it's not our wishes but carma rules outcome of this trip and if there are some sudden changes or obstacles in the tour program then he/she promises not to have any objections against the organizers of this trip.
